Autumn Booster Campaign 2023

Patients eligible for an autumn Covid booster:

- Residents in care homes for older adults
- All adults aged 65 years and over or 65 years before 31 March 2024
- People aged 6 months to 64 years in a clinical risk group.
- Frontline health and social care workers.
- People aged 12 to 64 years who are household contacts of people with immunosuppression.
- People aged 16 to 64 years who are carers. Those who are eligible for a carer's allowance, or those aged 16 years and over who are the sole or primary carer of an elderly or disabled person who is at increased risk of COVID-19 mortality and therefore clinically vulnerable.

Patients eligible for the flu include:

- Patients in long stay residential care homes
- Patients aged 65 years and over
- Those aged 6 months to under 65 years in a clinical at risk group
- Pregnant women
- Carers
- Close contacts of immunosuppressed individuals
- Frontline health and social care staff (patient contact)
- Children aged 2 or 3 years on 31st August 2023
- Primary school children (reception to Year 6) and Secondary school children (Years 7-11) will be offered their vaccination as part of the School Immunisation Programme.
- **Patients aged 50-64 years that are not in an at risk group/carers are not currently eligible. This may be subject to change following advice from the Joint Committee on Vaccination and Immunisation.**
